<b>Reviewed by</b> <a href="#">Monica Lerner</a>	This is a terrific expression of Barbera from a warm vintage that is well suited to the variety. The 2015 Barbera d'Alba Superiore Scassa opens to deep, dark and savory tones with ample richness and concentration at the rear. Some 23,000 bottles were produced. On the close, the wine veers toward a savory or smoky personality that suits it nicely. This wine stays in reduction during winemaking but becomes suddenly explosive and bright when poured into the glass.

<b>Reviewed by</b>  <a href="#">Monica Larnar</a>	Camilla is the name of a vineyard plot in Grinzane Cavour (along the small road at the back of the winery) that is only farmed by Bruna Grimaldi and her family. The 2014 Barolo Camilla shows very nice results with delicate and soft fruit. The vines are 40 years old, and the bouquet is especially marked by floral tones of rose hip and pressed violets. Skin maceration times are extended up to 30 days, but this expression of Nebbiolo remains silky and compact nonetheless.

This cooler vintage has shaped a wine with ample backbone to support dark fruit, spice and licorice. However, despite that immediate girth and power, this wine reveals a more ethereal and delicate approach on closer inspection. The final words spoken here are subtle and soft.

The 2014 Barolo Badarina benefits from southeast exposures for greater power and textural richness. The bouquet offers earthy aromas of truffle, forest floor and tangy berry on the close. Those hearty soil or rust-like aromas are often more present in Nebbiolo from this celebrated village. Ultimately, this wine is long and profound, with pretty menthol notes on the finish.
